

Library awarded an Edge Action Plan Grant

The St. Clair County Library was recently awarded an Edge Action Plan Grant totaling \$18,000 from Missouri Secretary of State Jay Ashcroft.

"Our libraries are an invaluable resource to Missourians, offering public access to a wide



array of materials and technology," Ashcroft said. "These grants ensure libraries have the funds they need to offer quality technology-based services and programs to their patrons."

The library used the grant to replace various technology components including: ten public workstations, color printer/copier/scanner/fax machine, microfilm scanner, laptop for bookmobile, barcode scanners, and two high-visibility keyboards for our visually impaired.

Edge is a nationally recognized tool that helps libraries evaluate their technology services based on a set of national technology benchmarks, giving them resources, recommendations, and ideas for strategic planning and community engagement.

A press release from Ashcroft's office said, "Edge Action Plan Grants provide funds to assist public libraries in completing goals they set from using Edge. Projects may address needs for new or expanded technology-based services or the replacement of outdated technology at the library, as identifed through an Edge Assessment."

The Secretary of State's State Library has approved a total of 15 grant applications in the 2020 fisscal year, totaling \$158,934 in federal awards that the secretary's office has distributed to libraries throughout Missouri. The grants are funded by the Library Services and Technology Act through the U.S. Institute of Museum and Library Services. These much needed upgrades, will allow the St. Clair County Library to continue to meet our communities ever-growing technological needs.
